Artwork Installation, Haverstock School

A 5m high structure, from interlocking aluminium coloured strips, forming a three-dimension spiral and an eye-catching feature in the entrance to the new Haverstock School in North London. Designed by the international artist Kisa Kawakami, the installation was first modelled at one-quarter full size, to check the complicated relationship between angles and inter-sections, and was then fabricated and constructed in-situ on the school premises in an eight-hour night-shift so as to minimise disruption of the school activities.
