Product design-development, manufacture, and installation, of a work package totalling £1.6 million in 1992, which included Aerofoil Signage Enclosures for Ticket Sales and Passenger Information, Stainless Steel Payphone Units with Double Curved Glass Panels, Feature Cladding to Escalators and Conveyors and the Passenger Information Board, Feature Louvres, Louvres and Cladding to Car Park Ventilation Towers, 400 metres of stainless steel custom-perforated and formed external feature cladding to the West Elevation, Stainless Steel decking to the end-of-platform Escape Zone, and the Cladding and Louvres to the Main Car Park Ventilation Towers to Platform 19.
